Nominations for Recognition as Young “Difference-Makers” will be considered based on the following:
Initiative, Benefit to others, as measured in Short and/or Long-Term Impact, and Generosity.

Past examples of Young “Difference-Makers” who have received recognition:

- A middle school student gave of her time to help a student with special needs.
- A high school student designed and sold t-shirts in support of teacher with cancer.
- An elementary-aged student ran a lemonade stand and sold T-shirts to raise money for ALS awareness.
- Two students, grades 7 and 10, created a prayer chain to support troops at a US Naval Air station.
- A group of high school students produced a video to address teen depression and suicide.

1. Please complete each question on the attached entry form, limiting your response to the space provided. Be complete, clear and concise. (Any individual, age 18 and over, related to the student or not, may make a nomination.)
2. Any supporting documents, i.e. photos, news articles, etc., should enhance material previously discussed in the nomination form. (Limit 2 pages)
3. The nomination form and any supporting documents are due March 1, 2018. One copy of each page is acceptable. (Originals will not be returned.) **IMPORTANT: Incomplete or late entries will not be reviewed.**
