Are you a female non-traditional student looking to get more education to move your life forward with a better job?

If so, we encourage you to apply for the new Women's Fund Scholarship!

The goal of this minimum \$500 scholarship is to create opportunity for any female Ashland County resident who may need "a boost" to create a better life for herself and her family.

Who is eligible?

- Non-traditional student = Ashland County resident (90 days minimum) over the age of 24 and entering college for the first time or starting again after not being enrolled for at least one year. Continuing students are ineligible.
- High school graduate (from any high school) or GED earned
- Planning to attend any type of higher education (to include traditional 2 or 4 year schools, vocational schools, adult education programs, certificate programs, etc.)
